

Road Closures

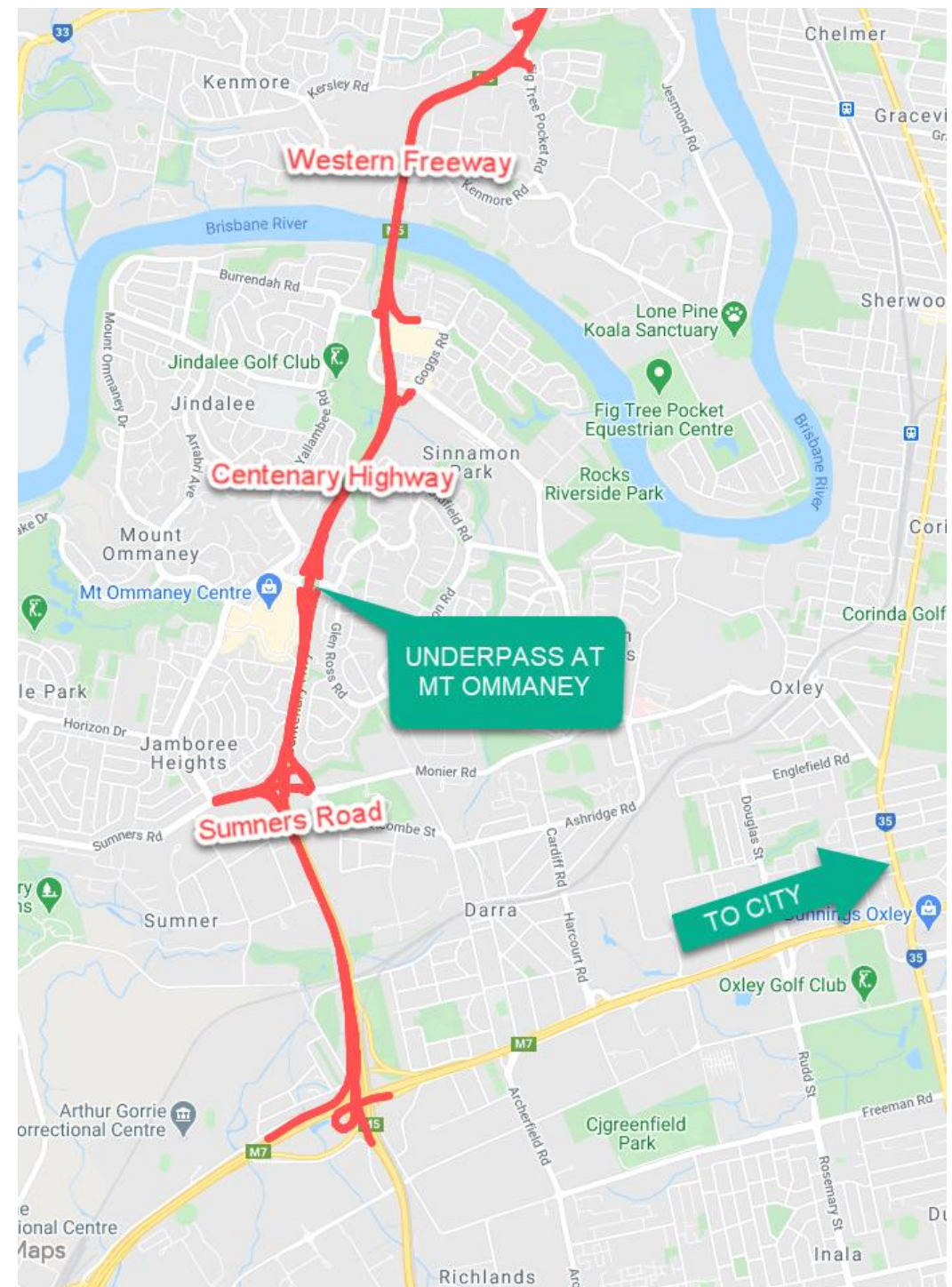
Road closures will be in place during the event to ensure competitor safety in accordance with the international event sanctioning.

A significant police presence and traffic control operation will be in place to assist motorists.

Roads will open as the last rider passes each checkpoint.

There will be road closures throughout the Brisbane Metropolitan area on **Sunday 11 July** for the Tour de Brisbane. The following roads in your area will be closed **from 05:00am to 09:30am**:

- Ipswich Motorway Offramp To Centenary Highway Northbound – Eastbound and Westbound Ramps
- Sumners Rd – between Dandenong Rd and Monier Rd
- Western Freeway and Centenary Highway Southbound – between Moggill Rd and Ipswich Motorway
- Western Freeway and Centenary Highway Northbound – between Moggill Rd and Ipswich Motorway
