## CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

**Sunday 2 April 2023**



Brisbane is hosting the annual Brisbane Cycling Festival presented by King St and Australian Unity Tour de Brisbane on the weekend of Thursday 30 March to Sunday 2 April 2023. This is a bike ride event supporting the Prince Charles Hospital and The Common Good to raise funds and awareness for medical research.

Road closures will be in place throughout Metropolitan Brisbane on Sunday 2 April 2023 to ensure competitor safety in accordance with the international event sanctioning.

Local Council, State Government and the Emergency Services have all contributed to the planning of this event. Emergency vehicles will maintain the right of way as coordinated by Queensland Police.

This event includes a significant police presence and traffic control operation. There are curfews in place for participants and roads will open progressively as the last rider passes each checkpoint.

We kindly ask that you plan ahead for your travel and review the planned changes to traffic conditions and road closures in your area and across Brisbane.

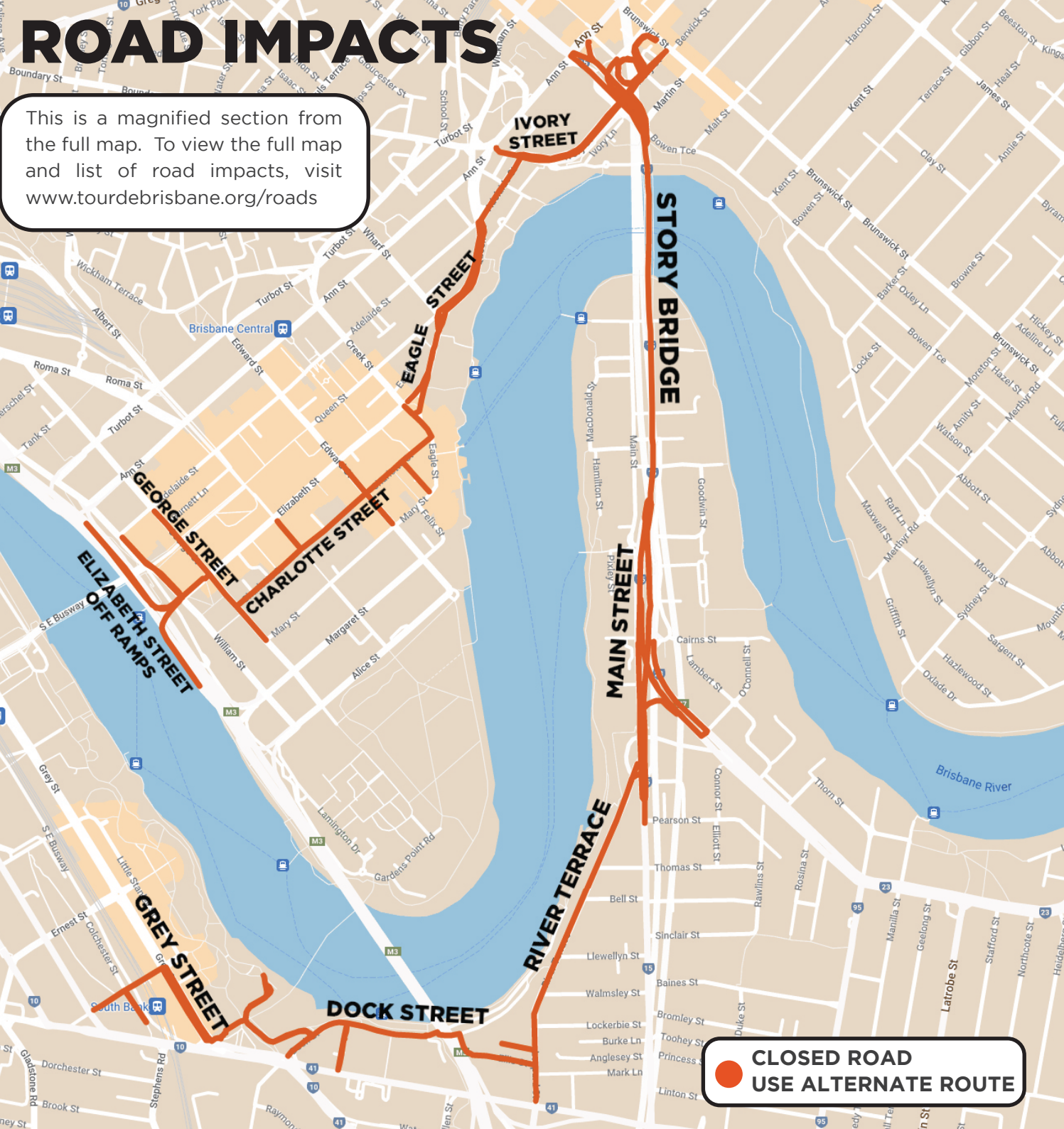
